What is Girls' Brigade (GB)?

GB is an international uniformed organisation. It aims to help girls to learn about the Christian faith whilst having lots of fun at the same time!

GB is split into four age groups:

1. Explorers—ages 4 -7 (School Years R-2)
2. Juniors—ages 7-9 (Years 3-5)
3. Seniors—ages 10-12 (Years 6-8)
4. Brigaders—ages 13+ (Year 9+)

Each year, girls work towards a badge.

In order to achieve this badge they do four sets of 'badgework' based on each of the following parts:

- Spiritual
- Physical
- Educational
- Service



This spells 'SPES' which is the Latin word for 'Hope' - the 'Hope' that we have for the future of each and every girl who undertakes badgework with GB.

When and where does 1st Torquay Girls' Brigade meet?

- Senior and Brigader sections meet 7-8.30pm
